## The family will:

1. Make sure their child arrives at school on time and is properly dressed and equipped.

2. Make sure their child regularly attends school and, in the case of absence, telephone school to explain the reason.

3. Notify the school of illness or change of circumstances affecting their child, or the family, of which the school ought to be reasonably aware.

4. Make the school aware of any concerns or problems that might affect their child's work or behaviour.

- 5. Attend parent evenings held to discuss their child's progress.
- 6. Support the school policies and guidelines for behaviour.

7. Encourage their child to read at home regularly through sharing books together and listening to their child read.

8. Encourage their child to regard school as an opportunity for enjoyment through learning.

9. Ensure their child makes healthy food choices to ensure a nutritionally balanced diet.

10. Ensure photos or videos containing images of pupils are not posted on any form of social media.

11. Communicate with the school community through class or school emails to support wellbeing and the learning of their child.

## **Together we will:**

1. Encourage the children to keep the school behaviour policy and rules.

2. Support the children's learning to help them achieve their best.

3. Use any photographs/video images taken at school only in the family or school context, and not post any images on the internet, without prior consent.

- 5. Promote the safe and responsible use of internet/electronic devices

6. Work in partnership to ensure all children have strong foundations in their learning journey.
