Check with his/her teacher to obtain this private information OR ask them to add you as a parent via email!



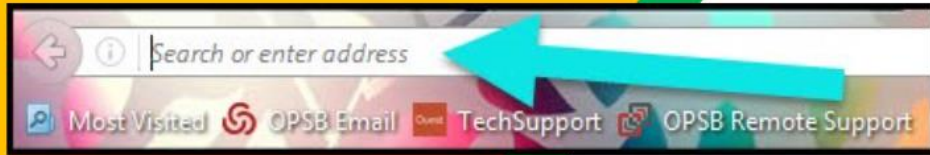

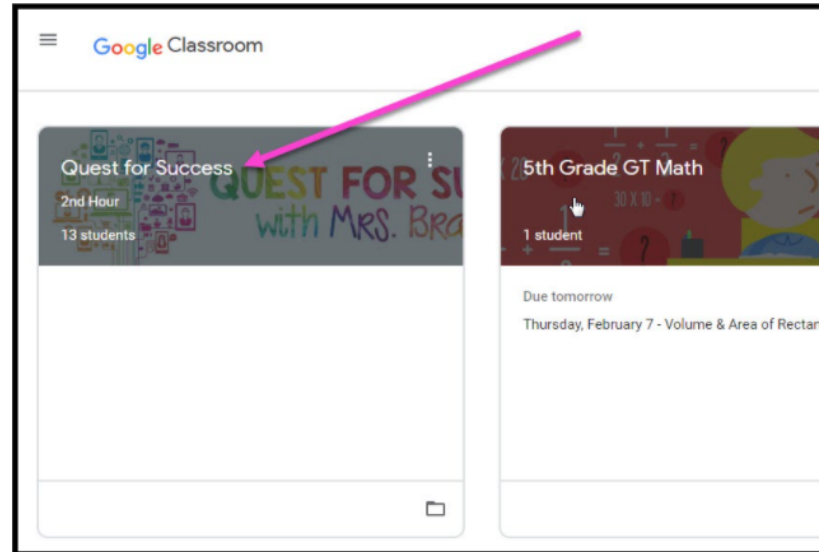
