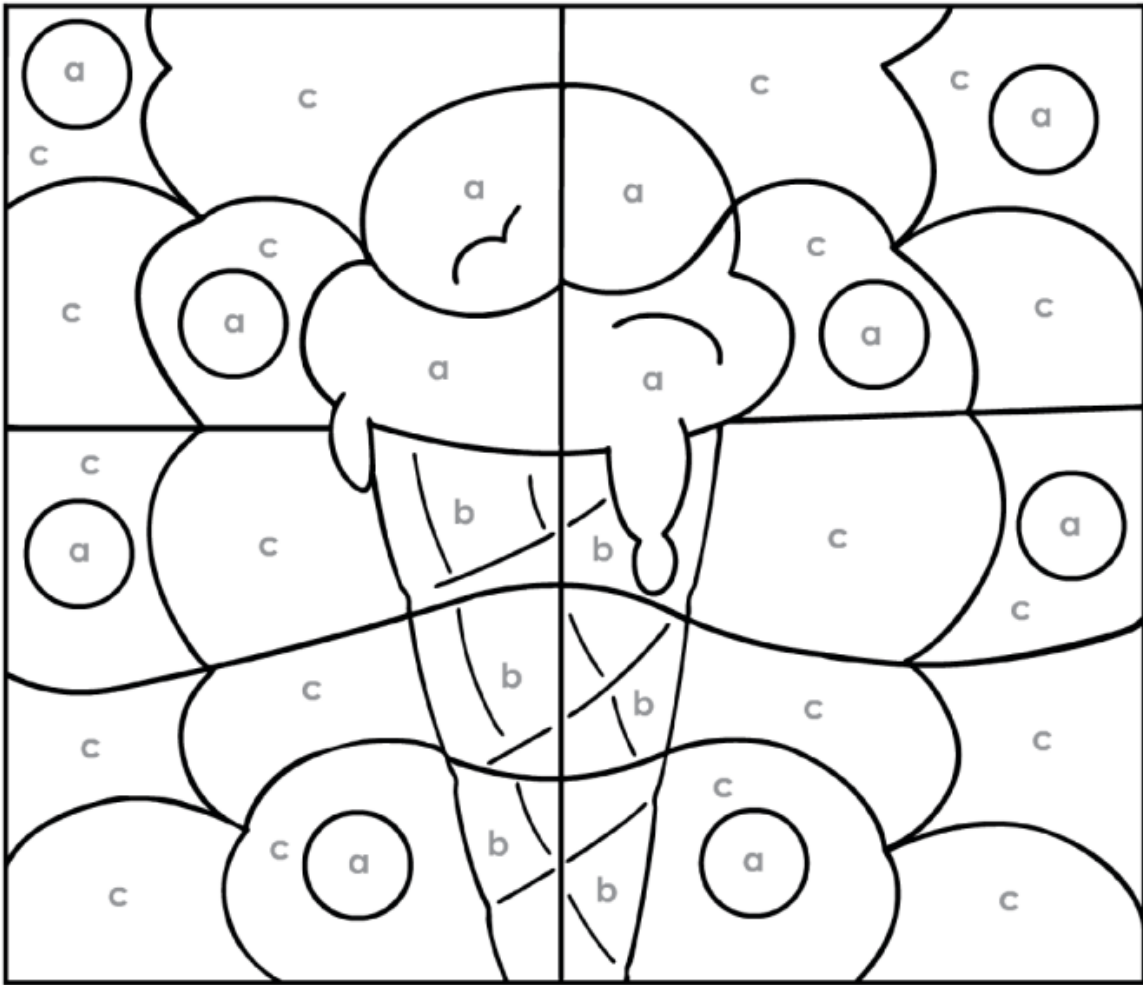

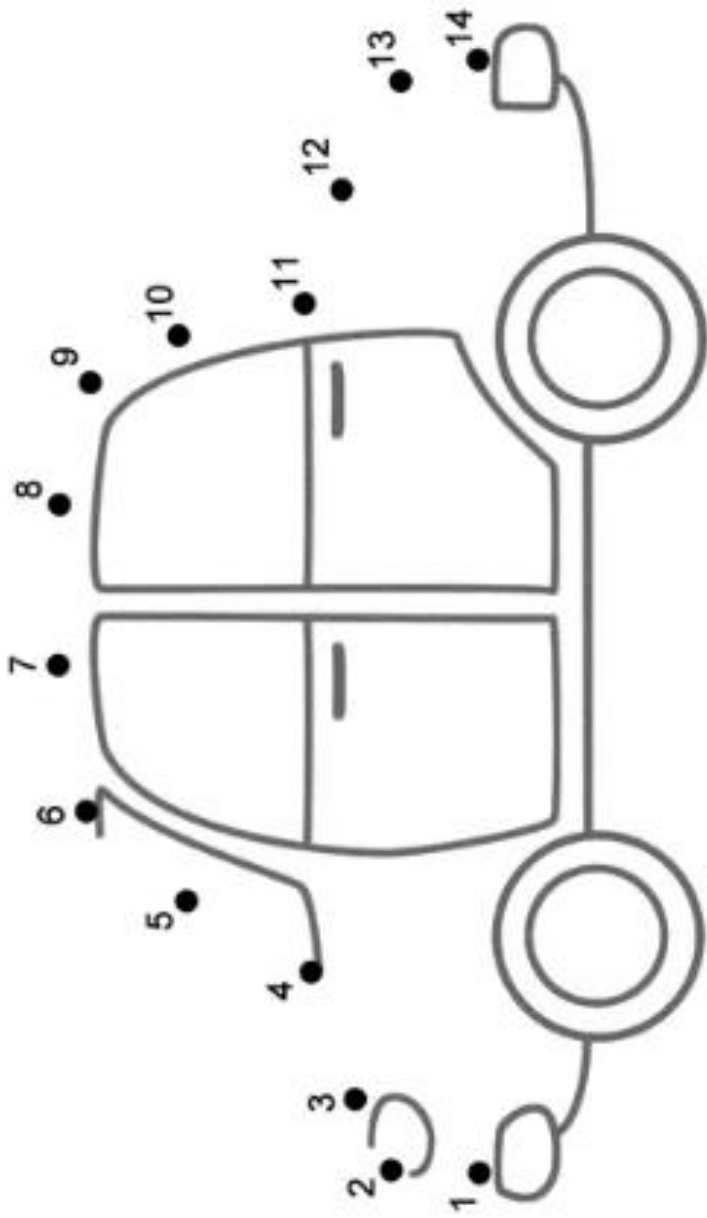

ABOUT THE RECIPE

Jam tarts are humble, cheap to make and such a pretty little treat. This is a great recipe to do with the kids.

INGREDIENTS

SWEET PASTRY

250g plain flour, plus extra for dusting

250g icing sugar

125g unsalted butter, softened

1 large egg

1 orange or lemon

a splash of milk

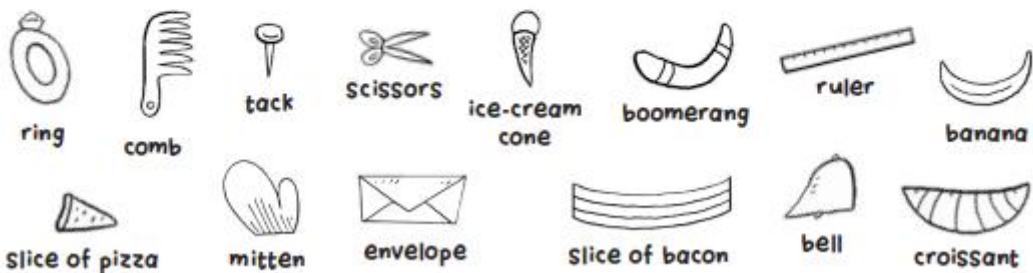
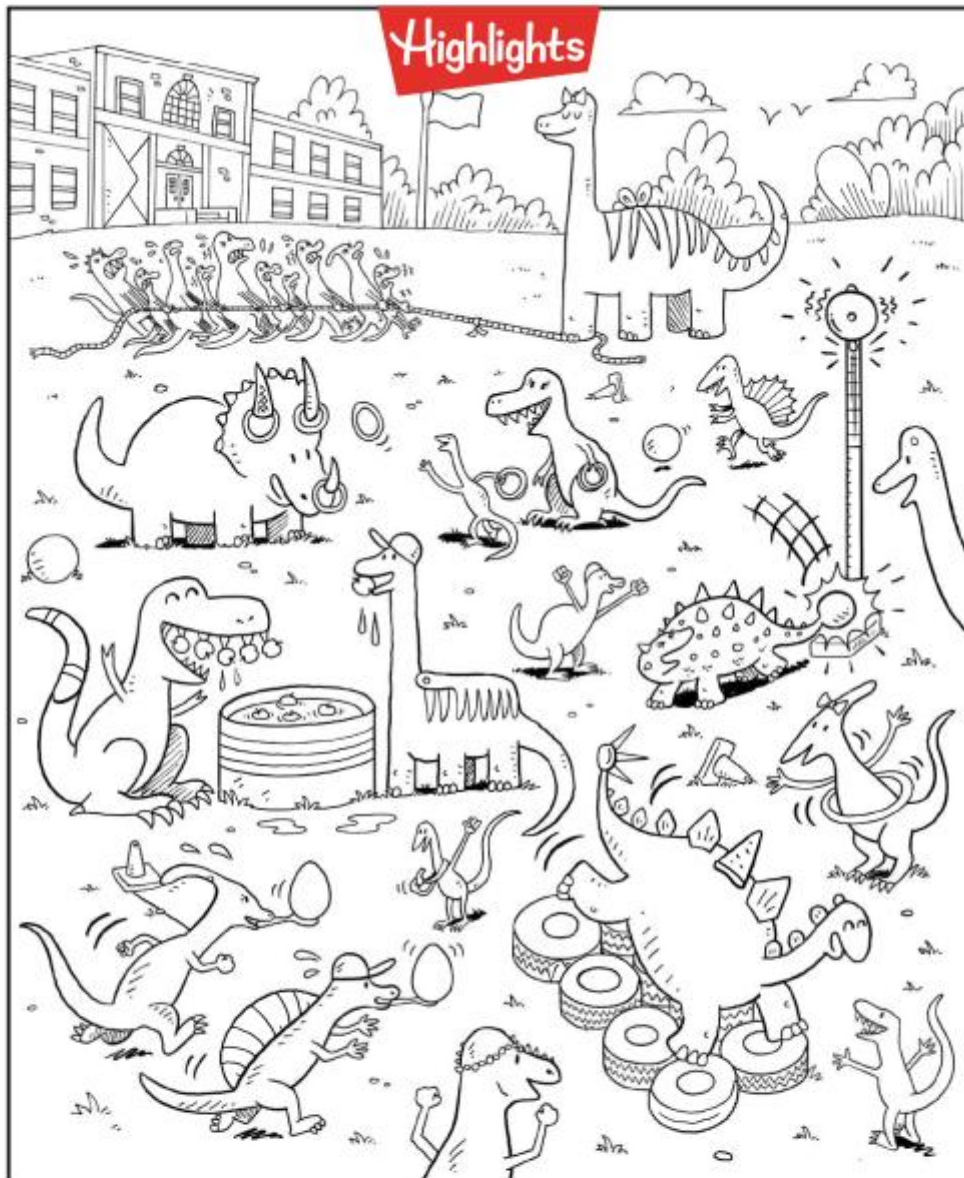
FILLINGS

30 heaped teaspoons of your favourite jams, curds, marmalades and jellies

METHOD

- 1 Jam tarts are definitely a part of my childhood. They are humble, cheap to make and such a pretty little treat. It's funny how simple pastry with a blob of jam can turn into something so exciting, with chewy bits, bubbling bits, crunchy bits and jammy jelly bits. Even if you cheat a little, and buy ready-made pastry, just the ritual of filling these tarts with your favourite jams and then baking them can be really relaxing. The beauty of these for me is playing with the different jam or jelly flavours so you get a rainbow of colours. Just about every supermarket in Britain stocks a great selection of posh jams: strawberry, blackberry, blueberry, gooseberry, apricot, cranberry ... the sheer number of fillings available now makes these even more exciting than the ones I had as a kid.
- 2 Put the flour, sugar and butter into a food processor with a pinch of sea salt and pulse until you have a mixture that looks like breadcrumbs. Crack in the egg, grate in the zest from your orange or lemon and pulse again, adding a little splash of milk to bring everything together, if needed. Wrap the dough in clingfilm and pop it into the fridge to rest for 30 minutes.
- 3 Preheat the oven to 180°C/350°F/gas 4. Dust a clean surface and a rolling pin with flour and roll out the pastry so it's 0.5cm thick. Get yourself a few 12-hole jam tart trays (or cook the tarts in batches) and a fluted pastry cutter just a little bigger than the holes of the tray (normally around 6cm). Cut out rounds of pastry and gently push them into the wells so they come up the sides. Any leftover pastry can be gently pushed back into a ball and rolled out to make a few more tarts. Put 1 heaped teaspoon of filling into each jam tart, interspersing and alternating the flavours of jams, curds or jellies.
- 4 Pop the trays on the middle shelf of the oven and cook for around 12 to 15 minutes, or until the pastry is golden and the filling is thick and bubbling. Remove from the oven, leave in the tray to firm slightly, then transfer to a wire rack and leave to cool for a few minutes before serving.

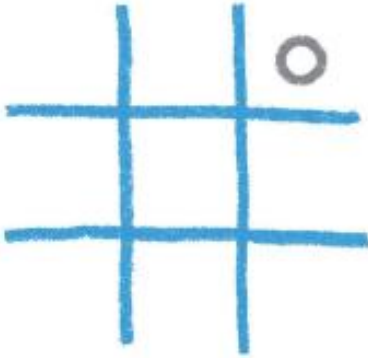

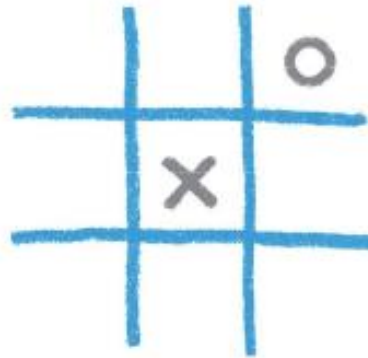

Os and Xs instructions

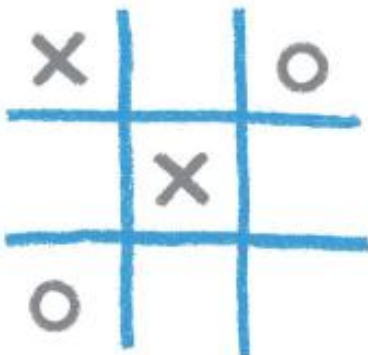
- 1 Player 1 marks an O in any of the spaces in the grid.



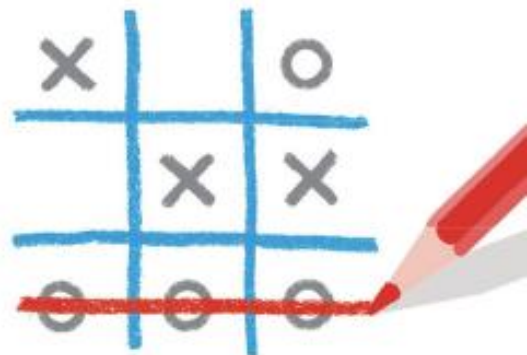
- 2 Player 2 marks an X in any of the other spaces.

Design Your Own Flip Flops Craft

We had such fun with this flip flops craft! It is a perfect group activities - perhaps for a summer party, or a long rainy afternoon with friends - and uses up all your scraps of paper, wrapping paper, card and ribbon! Younger children will enjoy the same craft using craft foam, card and pipe cleaners.



You could use these flip flops to decorate your house, your fridge, or the front of an invitation or birthday card. A particularly nice pair can even be framed (leave out the glass) to make a cute picture for your child's bedroom wall.

You will need:

- An assortment of card, paper, wrapping paper (gift wrap), craft foam, etc
- Ribbons and braids (or pipe cleaners for younger kids)
- Scissors and glue
- Decorations such as beads, plastic or silk flowers, stickers etc can be used if you like.
- Template

Instructions:

Print out the Flip Flops Template and cut out the individual pieces. Younger kids will just need the bigger pair of flip flops; older kids will want to use both.



For younger kids -

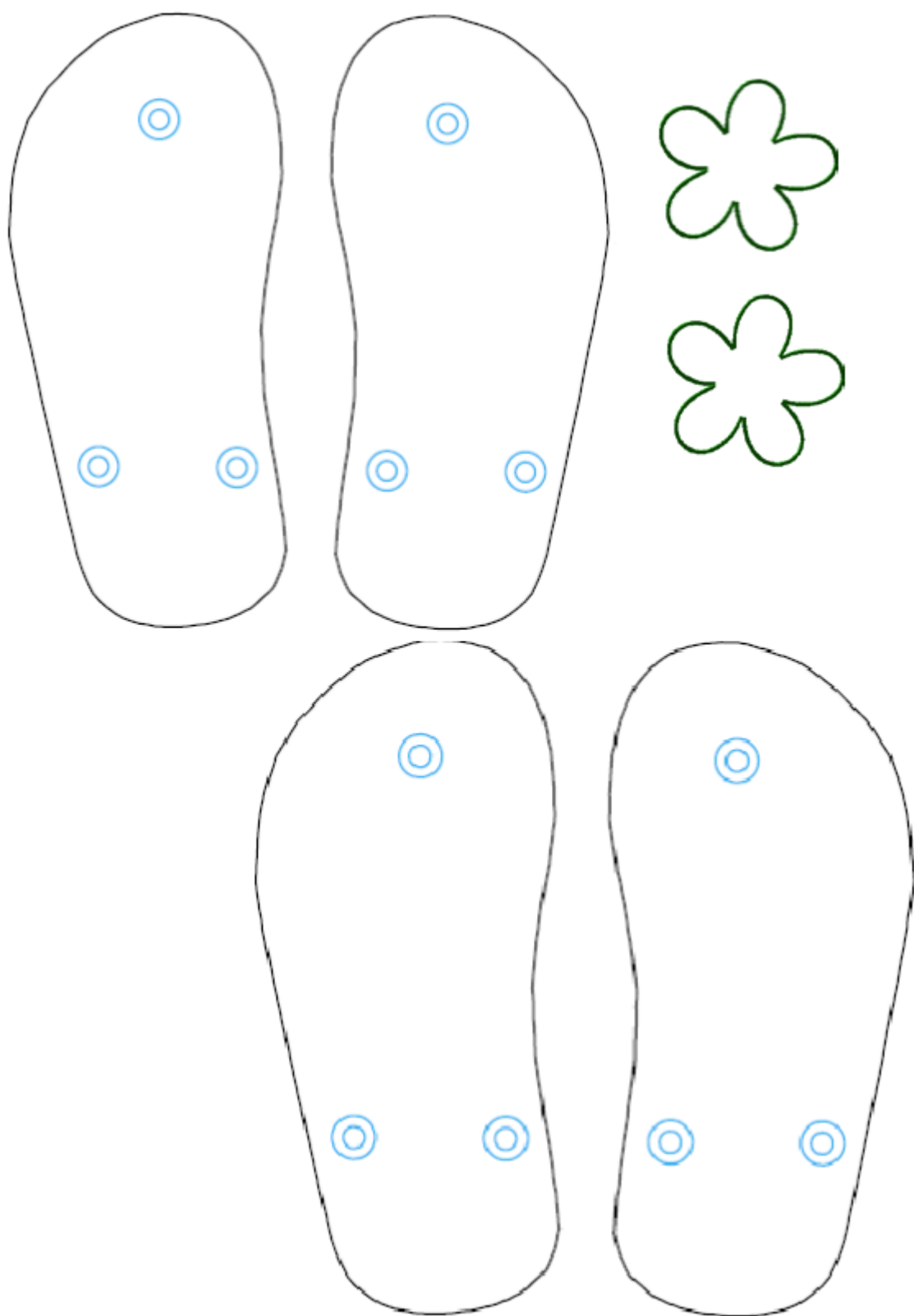
Using the larger two templates, draw round them onto the craft foam and carefully cut out. An adult should pierce three holes in the flip flops where shown on the template (we used a pencil, but you could also use nail scissors or a metal skewer or bradawl). Use two pipe cleaners per flip flop, as shown in the photo above, bending the pipe cleaner backwards on the underneath of the flip flop to hold it in place.

We further decorated our flip flops by cutting a small circle of craft foam and threading the pipe cleaners through that as well, and also by threading beads onto the pipe cleaner before pushing it through the second hold.

For older kids -

Use two different materials for your flip flops, cutting the larger templates from one and the smaller templates from the other. Pierce three holes in the smaller template, then thread pieces of ribbon or cord through the holes (we found it easier if we pushed our ribbon through the holes with a sharp pencil). Use sticky tape to fasten the ribbon on the underneath of the flip flop, then glue the top of the flip flop to the bottom, sandwiching the ends of the ribbon in between.

If you like, you can cut the flower shapes out and use them to finish off your flip flops. Alternatively use beads, plastic flowers, hearts or butterflies or even pompoms to decorate them!

GROWING GRASS HEADS IN A CUP

SUPPLIES:

- Plastic cups
- Soil or dirt from your yard
- Grass seeds
- Construction paper
- Water
- Scissors
- Hot glue/hot glue gun

INSTRUCTIONS

STEP 1. Fill the cups about 3/4 way with soil.



STEP 2. Sprinkle enough seeds on top to cover the soil (do not cover the seeds with more soil).

STEP 3. Place in a sunny window inside your house.

STEP 4. Water the grass seed cups morning and night.

STEP 5. The seeds will take about 7-10 days to start growing.



STEP 6. Once you have long grass, you can cut out a nose, mouth and eyes from the colored construction paper.

STEP 7. Glue the nose, mouth and eyes onto the front of the cups and the grass will act as hair.



STEP 8. For fun... Once the grass is overgrown, give them a “haircut”.



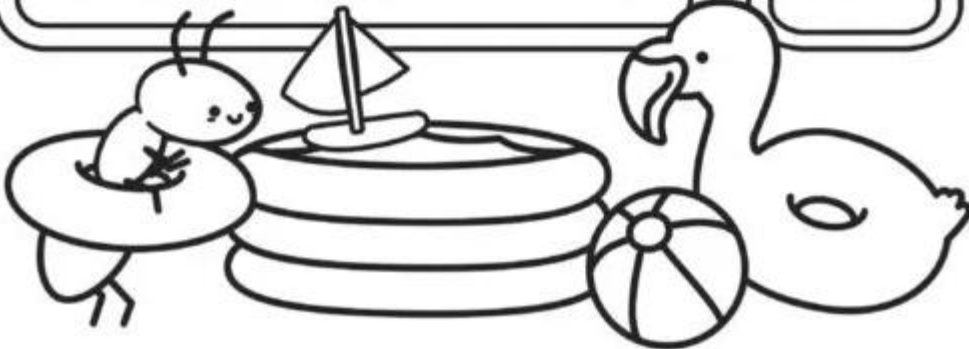

Bubble Painting

Bubble painting is a fascinating crafty activity for kids, which produces different results every time. It can be a bit messy though. Take it outdoors and it makes a great outdoor summer activity!



You will need:

A tray or bowl big enough to fit your paper in
Paint
Washing up liquid
Drinking straw
Paper

Instructions:

Mix together the paint and some washing up liquid in the tray. Add some water until it is runny enough to blow bubbles. Use the drinking straw to blow into the paint to make bubbles.

Gently place the paper on top of the bubbles. When the bubbles pop remove the paper and leave to dry.

Pizza pockets



Ingredients

1 tbsp olive oil

1 large garlic clove, crushed

1 tsp dried oregano

400g tin chopped tomatoes

2 x 400g packs pre-rolled pizza dough, or 2 x 375g packs ready-rolled puff pastry

150g/5½oz mix of grated mozzarella and cheddar

1 free-range egg, beaten

For the pepperoni filling

16 slices pepperoni, halved (2 slices per pocket)

For the ham and pineapple filling

4 large slices ham, chopped

227g tin pineapple slices, drained and chopped

For the vegetarian filling

1 small red pepper, seeded and thinly sliced

80g/2¾oz sweetcorn (tinned is fine)

Method

1. Heat the oil in a pan over a medium heat, add the garlic and oregano and cook for 30 seconds, until fragrant. Add the tomatoes and simmer for 10–15 minutes until thickened, stirring from time to time and breaking up the lumps of tomato. Leave to cool.
2. Unroll the pizza dough (or pastry) and divide each piece into four. Put a spoonful of the tomato sauce on one half of each of the eight pieces of dough. Add your chosen filling, then the cheese. Brush the edges of the dough with beaten egg, then fold the uncovered side over the filling. Press the edges together and crimp with a fork to seal.
3. Chill in the fridge for 30 minutes. Preheat the oven to 200C/180C Fan/Gas 6.
4. Bake the pizza pockets for 20 minutes, until golden and puffed. Leave to cool for 5 minutes before tucking in.
